## Fishing at the Sea Galilee

Also called the Lake of Gennesaret





Some of Jesus Disciples were introduced to Jesus by John the Baptist

"Behold The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world."

Andrew heard and went and found Peter his brother and took him to Jesus John 1:35-42



And Jesus, walking by the Sea of Galilee, saw two brothers,

Simon called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea; for they were fishermen.

Then He said to them, "Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men."

They immediately left their nets and followed Him

Going on from there, He saw two other brothers, James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother, in the boat with Zebedee their father, mending their nets.

"Master, we have toiled all night and caught nothing,


nevertheless at Your word I will let down the net."

When Simon Peter saw *it,* he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying,


> "Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord."

And when you have opened its mouth, you will find a piece of money;










#### Fishing with a Drag Net
